- ◆ Credits can be given to other school leaders

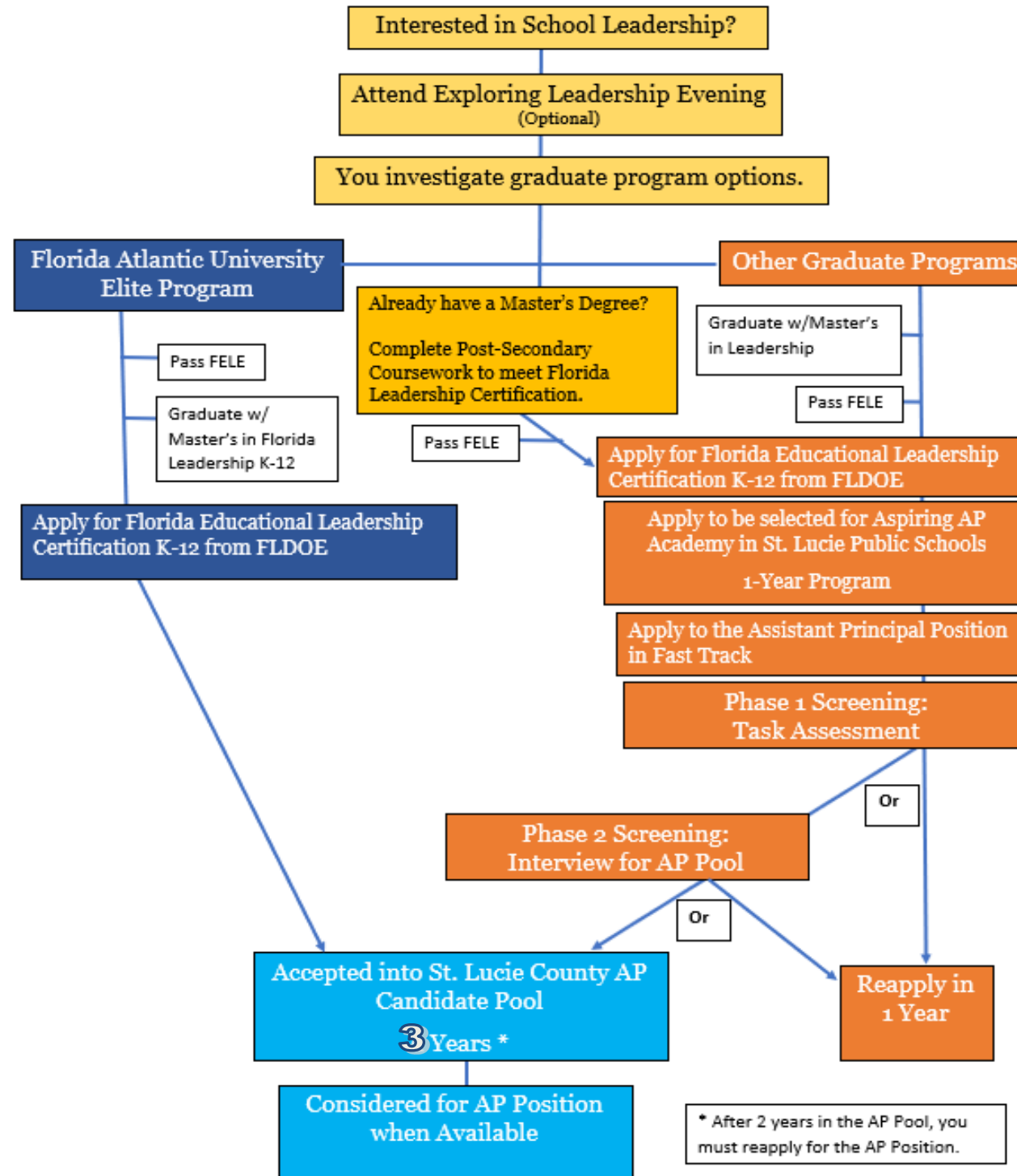
