Please describe the methods for delivering the instruction for each grade level.

Grades K to 5 students will receive direct-instruction in a classroom setting. In grades K-3, lessons will be delivered by the School Counselor and in grades 4 and 5, lessons will be delivered through the classroom teacher as an extension of the current health curriculum.

In secondary grades, two lessons of 55 minutes each will be delivered in a classroom setting. The curriculum will be integrated within *Canvas*, the District's online portal, to allow for facilitation by the certified teacher or through a district created video-based lesson. In grades 6-8, the lessons will be delivered through PE teachers as part of the Health curriculum. In grades 9-12, the lessons will be delivered by teachers at designated curriculum areas. (9th grade - Freshman Seminar, 10th grade - World History, 11th Grade - English 3, 12th Grade - English 4)

Please describe the materials and resources that will be utilized to deliver the instruction for each grade level.

Grades K-5. Suite360 will be used for elementary grades. Students will complete the lesson entitled, "Kid Power: The Power to Stay Safe."

Grades 6-12. Suite 360 will be used for grades 6-8 and 10-12 and complete the lesson entitled, "Child Trafficking Prevention." Grade 9 will use their School Connects curriculum through Freshman Seminar.

School Counselors, Psychologists and Social Workers will follow up with students who request additional information or assistance.
