Please describe the methods for delivering the instruction for each grade level.

Grades K to 5 students will receive direct-instruction in a classroom setting. In grades K-5, lessons will be delivered by the School Counselor.

In secondary grades, lessons of 55 minutes each will be delivered in a classroom setting. The curriculum will be available through the Clever portal. In grades 6-8, the lessons will be delivered through PE teachers as part of the Health curriculum. In grades 9-12, the lessons will be delivered by teachers at designated curriculum areas. (9th grade - Freshman Seminar, 10th grade - World History, 11th Grade - English 3, 12th Grade - English 4)

Please describe the materials and resources that will be utilized to deliver the instruction for each grade level.

Grades K-5. Suite360 will be used for elementary grades. Students will complete the lesson entitled, "Kid Power: The Power to Stay Safe."

Grades 6-12. Suite 360 will be used for grades 6-8 and 10-12 and complete the lesson entitled, "Child Trafficking Prevention." Grade 9 will use their School Connects curriculum through Freshman Seminar.
