DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Develop a high quality sequential and developmentally appropriate standards-based instrumental program. 2. Develop ensemble based classes focusing on individual instrumental musicianship. Instruments will included, but not be limited to world drums, guitars, keyboards, and other traditional wind instruments. 3. Design and implement a wide variety of appropriate instructional activities for students of various abilities and talents. 4. Collaborate with colleagues on arts related functions and arts integration within the school and community. 5. Demonstrate ability and willingness to work effectively with the band director, students, staff, parents and community. 6. Evaluate student achievement and adjust instruction accordingly. 7. Provide opportunities for students to highlight their talents/skills as an instrumentalist, through classroom performances, school functions, afterschool performances and community events. 8.
