DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Serves as the district’s multi-tiered systems of support (MTSS) lead. 2. Leads cooperative long-range planning and implementation of district wide MTSS/RTI. 3. Designs and facilitates rigorous professional development grounded in current research and best practices. 4. Builds strong working relationships, working with diverse groups of people, and contributing positively to a team. 5. Assists schools with data analysis to ensure instruction/intervention is matched to the needs of all students. 6. Provides coaching and support to school-based teams by modeling the skillful use of data to inform decision making. 7. Supports school-based teams with documentation related to the problem-solving process. 8. Monitors the fidelity of implementation of MTSS/RTI at the school and district level. 9. Provides technical assistance activities including walkthroughs and feedback necessary to implement a multi-tiered systems of support. 10. Develops an electronic professional development resource bank to ensure access for all stakeholders. 11. Develops, revises, and updates procedural manuals to align with federal state, and district requirements. 12. Maintains professional competence through reading, research, and participation in professional development activities aligned with the requirements of the position.
