<b>JOB GOAL</b>
To serve as a Magnet School Classroom Teacher and a STEAM Advocate for the Magnet Schools Assistance Program. Works with the principals, assistant principals, and the Magnet School Coordinator to develop daily practices, activities, and an implementation plan to meet grant goals.</li> <li>3. To facilitate professional development and model best practices.</li> <li>4. Serve on a district team with Advocates from each of the three Magnet Schools and the District Professional Development Team to develop, implement and evaluate a comprehensive Professional Development Plan.</li> <li>5. To help ensure that innovative educational practices are applied with fidelity across the three magnet school sites</li> <li>6. To remain current in all aspects of Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math (STEAM) educational practices.</li> <li>7. Participate in workshops, seminars, conferences and/or advanced coursework which further advance knowledge of current trends in effective instructional practices.</li> <li>8. To provide evidence of progress toward grant goals for reporting purposes.</li> <li>9. To perform assigned tasks in a timely and efficient manner.</li> <li>10.
