JOB GOAL
To help students learn how to develop resilience and adapt to a variety of situations.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. Bachelor's degree or higher.
2. Valid Florida Educator Certificate.
3. Minimum of (3) years of successful teaching experience.
4. Possesses interpersonal skills to work effectively with teachers, administrators, and families.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Provides instruction in resiliency characteristics which includes but is not limited to critical thinking and problem solving, responsibility, celebrating and overcoming adversity, grit, coping skills, respect, citizenship, empathy, gratitude, and mentorship and volunteerism.
2. Creates a classroom environment that is conducive to learning and appropriate to the maturity and interests of the students.
3. Plans meaningful lessons for all learners aligned with resiliency characteristics and implements the materials embedded in the state resiliency toolkit as they are released.
4. Encourages students to set goals for themselves and to monitor their progress toward achieving their goals.
5. Employs a variety of instructional techniques and instructional media, consistent with the physical limitations of the location provided and the needs and capabilities of the individuals or student groups involved.
6. Guides the learning process toward the achievement of goals – establishes clear objectives for all lessons, units, projects and communicates these objectives to students.
7. Assesses the accomplishments of students on a regular basis and provides feedback toward progress.
8. Implements appropriate behavioral and classroom management systems aligned with school wide positive behavior intervention and supports.
9. Maintains accurate, complete, and correct records as required by law, district policy and administrative regulation.
10. Effectively communicates with parents and guardians.
11. Maintains professional competence through reading, research, and participation in professional learning activities aligned with the requirements of the position
12. Performs all assigned tasks in a timely and efficient manner.
13. Performs other duties as assigned by the school administrator.

PHYSICAL DEMAND CLASS:
