Recommended Action	The Superintendent recommends the Board award ITB 25-06 to the responsive and responsible vendor as listed below, authorize Purchasing Department to renew the contract for three (3) additional one-year periods contingent upon annual contract performance review, the initial term contract to commence on 11/20/2024 through 11/19/2025; Option Year 1 - 11/20/2025 through 11/19/2026, Option Year 2 - 11/20/2026 through 11/19/2027, and Option Year 3 - 11/20/2027 through 11/19/2028, as presented and attached to the agenda.

Description: The purpose and intent of the Invitation to Bid is to secure prices and establish a term contract for ice cream and frozen specialty items for district schools.

Twenty-two vendors were solicited. One (1) response was received. The tabulation is attached for review. Purchasing staff reviewed the pricing submitted and determined it is in line with current market rates.
