ADDENDUM 1 TO RFP 22-16

This addendum is issued as a part of the aforementioned RFP. The changes incorporated herein are an amendment to and supersede those conditions shown in the original solicitation. The Proposer shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum by signing this form and returning with their submittal. Failure to do so may subject Proposer to disqualification.

Q1. What are the proposed summer programs start and end dates?

A1. Start and end dates have not been determined.

Q2. The RFP states 4,000 children will be served through the summer program, how many classrooms and how many teachers will be involved in the program?

A2. There is a possibility of up to 333 classrooms and teachers.

Q3. Is there a list available of science topics by grade to be covered in the summer program?

A3. No.

Q4. Do students have access to PC or Mac computers for the duration of this program?

A4. Students will have access to PC computers; however, we are looking for hands on curriculum and not computer based.

Q5. Would the district be willing/able to rent computers for student use if needed?

A5. We do not rent computers to students.

Q6. How many hours per week will the program run?

A6. The hours have not been determined; however, students will engage in STEM a minimum of 4 hours a week.

Q7. Can a vendor bid some grades and not others? For instance, could we bid grades 1-5 and not K?

A7. We are looking for a K-5 program. The kindergarten students will be exiting kindergarten at the end of the school year for 1st grade placement in the 2022-2023 school year.

Q8. Approximately how many students are in each grade?

A8. Approximately 400 students per grade level.
